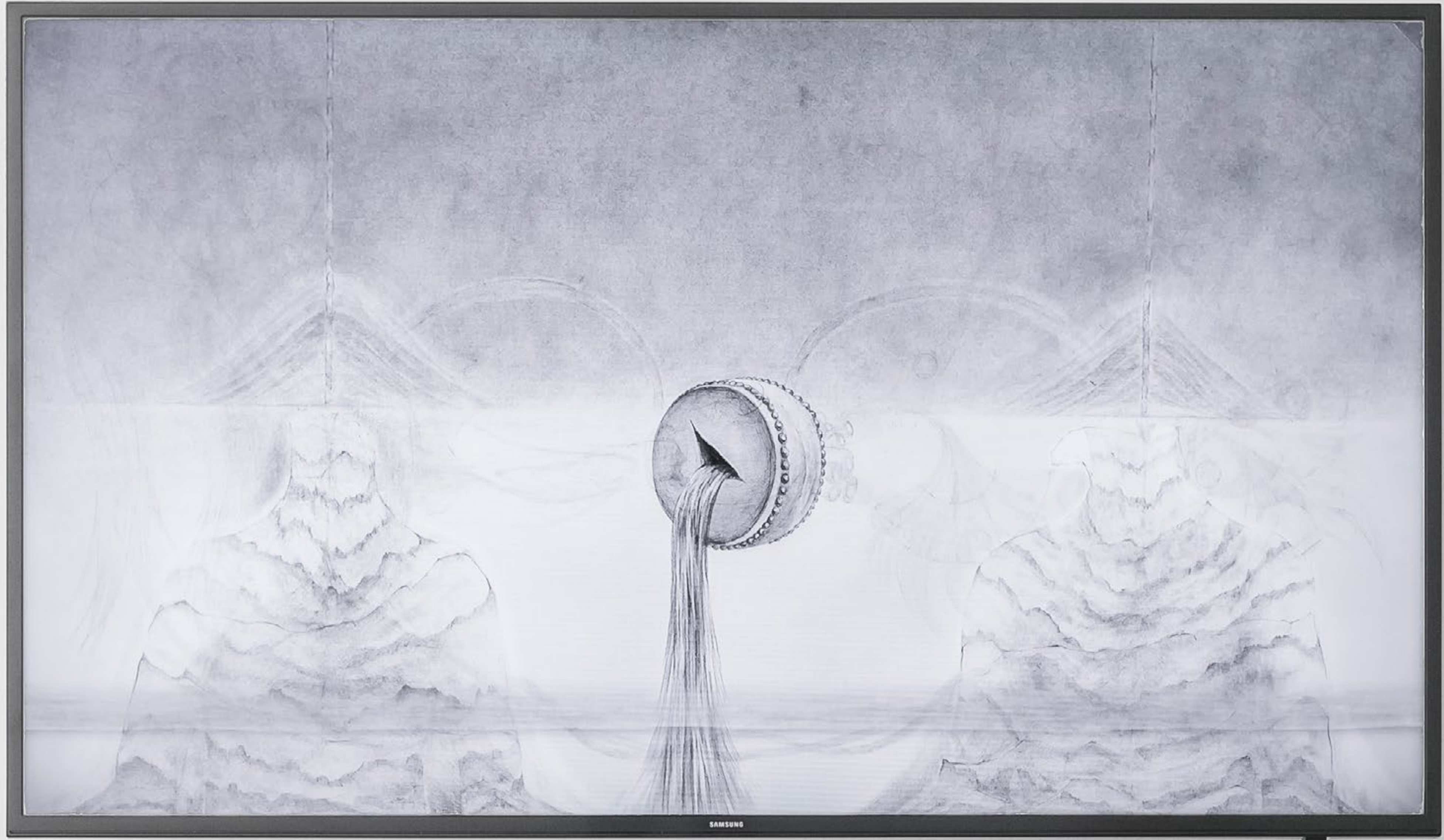
Becoming, 2017, pencil on paper, animation drawing, 10 minutes, moving image still



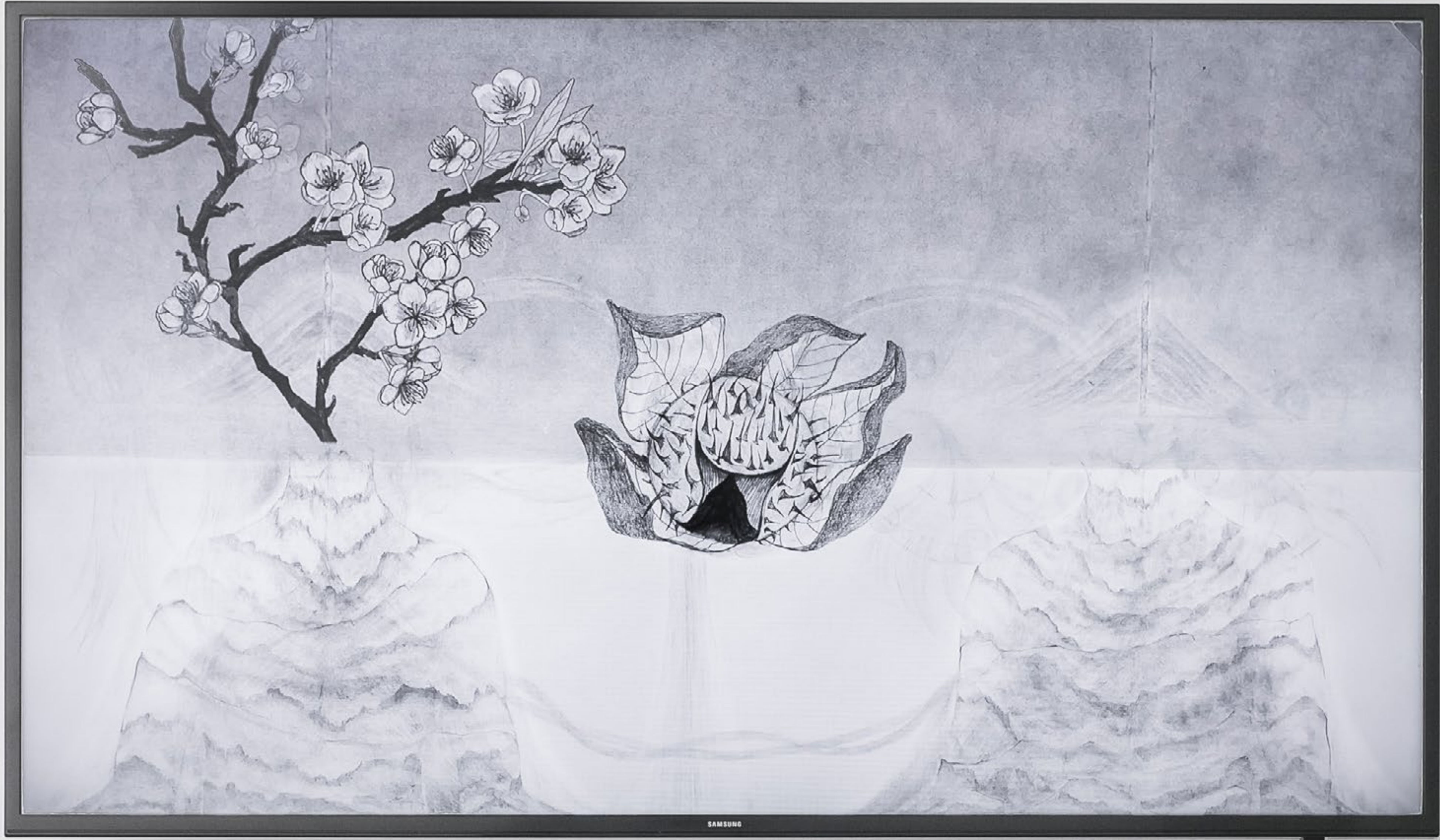
An endless cycle of transformation is stimulated by the essential elements of nature.

Based on Lee's belief that the internal world has a greater energy than the external world, the cabinet repeatedly opens and closes, transmitting the energy from the interior of the cabinet to the viewer. The internal energy further extends into the gallery space as the shallow pool installation reflects the image, literally intersecting into the external world.

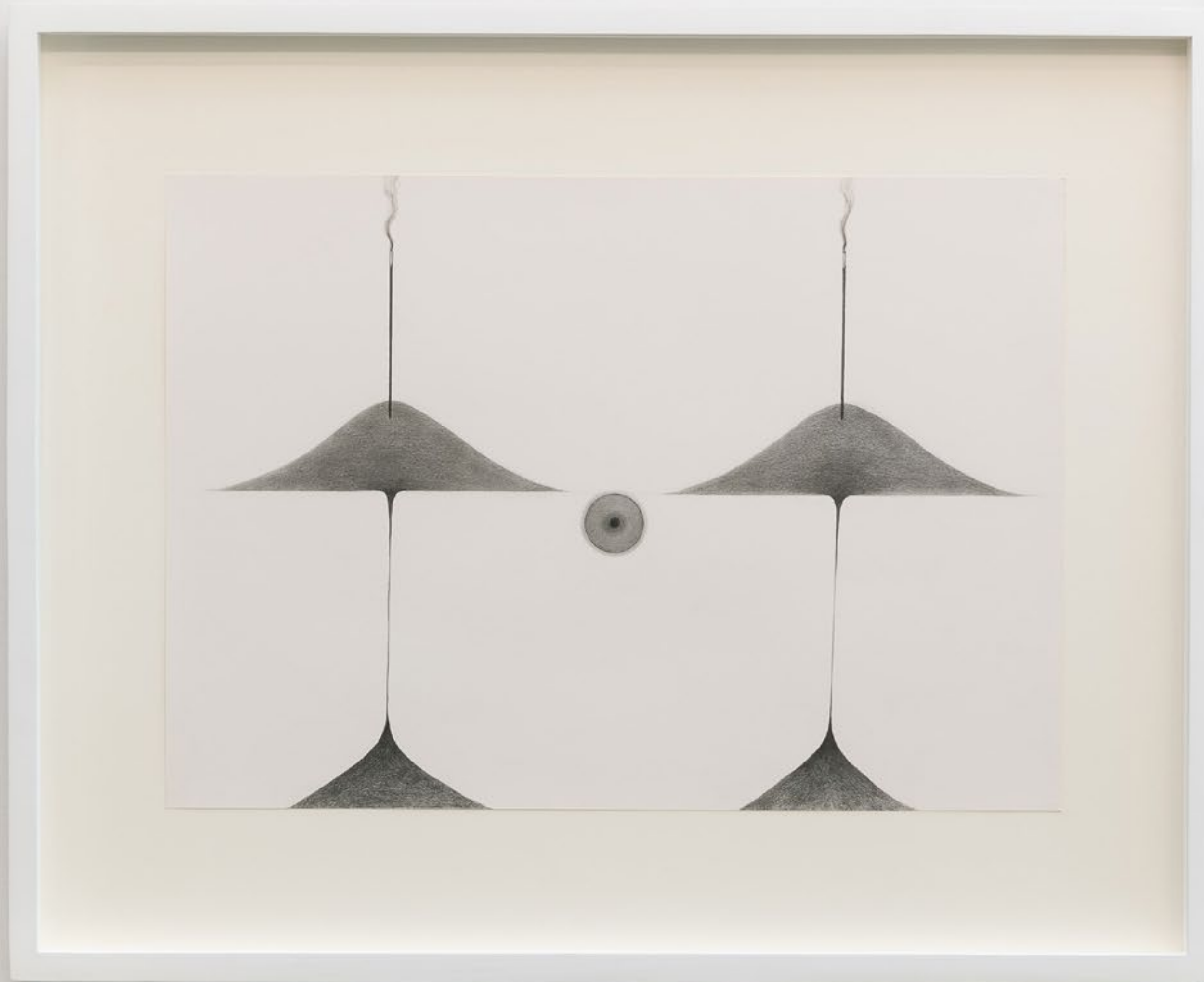
