The inappropriate and the unacceptable are constantly called into play, challenging the conventional way of understanding the world.
















A Frog, 2016, pencil on paper, animation drawing, 5 minutes, moving image still






A Lamp (Master Drawing)






Based on Lee's belief that the internal world has a greater energy than the external world, the cabinet repeatedly opens and closes, transmitting the energy from the interior of the cabinet to the viewer.

The internal energy further extends into the gallery space as the shallow pool installation reflects the image, literally intersecting into the external world.












A Cabinet (Master Drawing)




Becoming 03 2018 Pencil on paper 42h x 59.4w cm


