Born in Chongjin, North Korea in 1935, Yikyung Kim is one of Korea's most celebrated ceramic artists. Kim studied at Seoul National University and at the College of Ceramics at Alfred University in New York. She is professor emerita at Kookmin University, Seoul. Her ceramics are created using the ancient wheel-thrown techniques and combine the harmony of traditional shapes with modern functionality. Her work is included in the numerous public collections, including the National Gallery of Contemporary Arts, South Korea; British Museum, UK; National Museums of Scotland, UK; Victoria and Albert Museum, UK; Smithsonian Institution, USA; Philadelphia Museum of Art, USA. She lives and works in Seoul.
